Healthy School

As a healthy school, we ask that you provide a healthy lunchbox if your child does not have a hot dinner. This should include a sandwich, roll, wrap, pasta salad or something similar which will fill your child up. As part of their lunchbox you may include a treat, such as a chocolate biscuit, cake or crisps but we ask that you just include the one. Other items you could include are yoghurt, sliced fruit or vegetables, cheese, raisins. We do have several children in school with a nut allergy so please do not send nuts in to school.

Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 children receive a free piece of fruit daily as part of the School Fruit and Veg Scheme. This means that all children in Classes One and Two have fruit in school at snack time. Children in Classes Three and Four do not receive school fruit and so may bring in a healthy snack such as a piece of fruit for their snack at break-time. We do not allow biscuits, cakes or crisps at break-time. They may also choose to bring in an extra snack for the afternoon.
